THERE ARE CONSEQUENCES TO DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOUR.

Any person who violates the Respect Policy may be asked either to participate in resolving the issue or to leave the space for a period of time until the issue can be resolved. The amount of time will reflect the seriousness of the incident and/or the number of times it has occurred.
